

Overview - Criteria for Classification - Married Couples Tournament

In the past it proved to be a good solution to regulate the affiliation to a certain classification by installing a point system.

All players, including players from other nations, receive points for their league affiliation during the past season. The partners' points will be added up. As before, the tournament directors are allowed to change a couples' classification if there are valid reasons guaranteeing a more fair competition.

Point system for classification

Class B	All couples who have less than 181 points according to above chart
Class C	All couples who have less than 101 points according to above chart

If there are less than 5 entries, groups can be consolidated.
